Visitors' Information

Visitors are restricted to 2 Adult Visitors over the age of 16 plus children for each client.

Children are welcome but must be accompanied by an adult.

All visitors must be approved by the staff team **prior** to visiting. Clients are responsible for organising for their visitors' names to be put on the Approved List.

Pierpoint House is a Drug and Alcohol-free environment. You must be sure not to bring Alcohol or Drugs on to the premises and not to have personally used any drug or alcohol before or during your visit.

If you go into any licenced premises either traveling here or during lunch, you are expected to refrain from drinking alcohol or using drugs.

If you are unsure about any aspect of the above statement, please do not hesitate to speak to a staff member.

Allowed

You may bring in the following items for the Client to have on a weekly basis.

80 Cigarettes

Or

40 Cigarettes and 50g Tobacco

Or

75g of Tobacco.

Stamps

Envelopes

Writing Paper

All items brought in will be checked by the Support Workers on duty.

If any items are deemed unsuitable, an explanation will be given to you and you will be asked to take the item(s) back home with you when you leave

Not Allowed

We respectfully request that money, any food items, sweets, fruit or drinks of any description are not brought into the Centre for the clients use either during visiting or at a later time.

Please do **not** bring any of the following items for the Client, as these are not permitted:

- Cans, Bottles of soft drinks, anything in glass bottles.
- Deodorants, aerosols, perfume or any toiletries.
- Inappropriate cards. Inappropriate or new clothing, except with prior approval.
- Any newspapers, magazines or books.
- Cameras, mobile phones or pets.

If you are unsure of any of the above, please do not hesitate to approach a member of staff

NB: Using mobile phones in the House is not permitted.

Visitors are not permitted to smoke in the House.
